



# URAC Promoting green economy

UNEP's Green Economy Report4:

- Growth in income and employment is driven by public and private investments that **reduce carbon emissions and pollution**, enhance energy and resource efficiency, and prevent the loss of biodiversity and ecosystem services."
- Building green agriculture requires physical capital assets (.....) crop and livestock diversification;(.....); and appropriate farm level mechanization.
- Policy changes would particularly focus on the reduction and eventual removal of ecologically perverse subsidies that distort the true cost of unsustainable agricultural inputs.


- Land abandonment / marginalization

Industrial Hemp is still a niche crop, cultivated on ca. 15,000 ha in the European Union (2012).





Figure 1: Hemp Cultivation Area in the EU 1993 - 2012, Source: EU Commission 2012 – data for 2012 estimation only


