It provides a guarantee for public authorities that the project will be transformed into concrete actions with clearly defined roles and responsibilities, and that these actions will have a real impact on local communities. It helps governments and companies to plan transparently and not to forget that every action must have correspondent benefits. It is a practice to be adopted for participatory, transparent and effective management.

PM4SD® is a certified methodology by APMG, a world leading examination institute that accredits training and consulting organisations, and manages certification schemes for professionals.

The Training Course

The examination

APMG-International

The PM4SD® Foundation examination is a closed-book examination and is intended to address the knowledge and skills that demonstrate proficiency in the project management method PM4SD®.

- The exam session will take place the last day of the training.
- The Foundation examination will be 40 minutes duration, 50 minutes for nonnative English speakers and/or for people with disabilities.
- Each examination consists of 50 questions. The pass mark is 50% or more of the marks, i.e. 25 or more marks out of 50.
